Members of the jury will be elected at the first team captains meeting (Thursday, January 21, 2010 at 1900h, Algoma Rod and Gun Club).

JURY OF APPEAL

In accordance with Biathlon Ontario Policy.

START TIMES:

Start order will be decided after registration and communication to coaches will be done at the first coach meeting held Thursday, January 21, 2010 at 1900h at Algoma Gun Club.

The organizing committee reserves the right to change start time subject to weather conditions.

The organizing committee reserves the right to cancel or postpone races and to retain some of the entry fees to cover expenses.

Ontario Cup points will be awarded to the Jr. Boy and Jr. Girl Air Rifle Category and count towards the total point accumulation of all 2009-2010 Ontario Cup Races.

PROTEST

Protest forms will be available at the race secretary desk in the Competition Office. Protest must be submitted to the race secretary in accordance with IBU rules along with a \$25.00 (CAN) deposit.

Deposit will be returned only if the protest is upheld.

RULES

The event will be run in accordance with the IBU rules. Biathlon Canada rules and procedures will be used for competitors not carrying rifles.

.22 Senior Boys and Senior Girls: The athlete will not carry his/her rifle during the race. Rifle racks will be placed at the entry and exit of the range. Athletes will shoot prone and standing positions. The penalty loop will be 150 meters.

NOTE for .22 athletes: It is the responsibility of athletes to bring their personal .22 caliber rifles and ammunition. .22 Ammunition will not be available for purchase on site.

Current law and legislation regarding the possession and use of firearms must be followed and licences must be presented upon arrival for participation in this event.

Air rifle categories: The athlete will not carry his/her rifle during the race. The Junior Boys/Girls, Juvenile Boys/Girls, and Pre-Junior Boys/Girls categories will shoot prone position only. The penalty loop will be 100 meters for the Junior Boys/Girls, Juvenile Boys/Girls, and Pre-Junior Boys/Girls categories. Air rifles and pellets will be available on site.

AWARDS

Ontario Cup medals will be given to all categories in accordance with Biathlon Ontario Hosting policy.

ELIGIBILITY

All members of Biathlon Canada Divisions and USBA with a competitor membership card or those who obtain a day pass on the day of the competition are eligible to participate.
