PROTEST

Protest forms will be available at the race secretary office. Protest must be submitted to the race secretary in accordance with IBU rules along with a \$25.00 deposit. Deposit will be returned only if the protest is upheld.

RULES

The event will be run in accordance with the IBU rules. Biathlon Canada rules and procedures will be used for competitors not carrying rifles.

.22 Senior Boys and Girls: The athlete will not carry his/her rifle during the race. Rifle racks will be placed at entry and exit of range. Athletes will shoot prone and standing positions. The penalty for missed targets during Sprint race will be time TBD.

Air rifle categories: The athlete will not carry his/her rifle during the race. The Junior, Pre-Junior and Participation categories will shoot prone position only. The penalty for missed targets during sprint race will be time TBD. Air rifles and pellets will be available on site. Please indicate on the registration form if you need them.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of athletes to bring their personal .22 caliber rifles and ammunition. .22 ammunition will not be available for purchase on site.

Chelsea Nordiq will have some air rifles available however you are encouraged to bring your own.

AWARDS

An official category must have 3 registered athletes. Ontario Cup medals will be given to all categories in accordance with BION Hosting policy. Medals will follow am and pm competition final results.

ELIGIBILITY

All members of Biathlon Canada Divisions and USBA with a competitor membership card or those who obtain a day pass on the day of the competition are eligible to participate.
