TRAVEL

Charlo is located on the north shore of NB on Chaleur Bay, in the Atlantic time zone. The three closest airports for travel to Charlo are:

Bathurst – 75 km (small aircraft and limited numbers of flights daily)

Moncton – 280 km

Fredericton – 330 km

Please speak to your travel agent about flight arrangements, particularly if planning on arrival in Bathurst. Rental vehicles are available at all of the above airports.

Dalhousie, NB – 15 km

Campbellton, NB – 30 km

Beresford, NB – 62 km

Fort Kent, ME – 290 km

Charlottetown, PE – 400 km

Halifax Airport, NS – 500 km

Quebec City, QC – 500 km

Montreal, QC – 750 km



On-site Transport

It is recommended that teams drive to the area from the airport or home locations in their vehicles and then use them for local transport. Most major vehicle rental agencies are located in the area: Hertz: 1-800-263-0600, Budget: 1-800-268-8900 (or online).

MEALS

Teams are responsible for arranging their own meals during the event. A nutritious lunch will be provided to the athletes by the Organizers at the chalet on competition days. The cost is included in the registration fee. Snack items will be available for sale throughout. Non-athletes may also purchase lunches at the chalet for a cost of \$7.50. There will a banquet with a sit-down meal held the Saturday evening of the event week for a cost of \$30.

RIFLES

Teams and individual competitors from the USA must complete the necessary documentation, declare their rifles at the Canadian border, and pay the required fee when bringing their rifles into Canada. The required forms can be downloaded at:
