Registration

Online registration is available at SkiReg.com. There will be no telephone registration. Mail in registrations will be accepted until 26 January 2011. After that registration will only be accepted in person until 5PM Wednesday 26 January 2011. There will be no race day registration. Race bibs not picked up at the Team Captains Meeting will be available at the range on race day. Entry fee is \$50 USD. This includes both the Sprint and Pursuit events. The fee is the same for one or both races.

OTC Housing Requests

There are a limited number of beds available at the Olympic Training Center for this Nor Am. Rooms will be assigned on a first come - first served basis (2 people to a room). Only participating athletes, coaches and officials are eligible. Rooms and meals: \$45/day US Athletes, \$75 USD for International guests. Housing/meal costs must be paid directly to the USOTC not to the Lake Placid Biathlon Club. **Non-US citizens must fill out the USOC Passport and Visa Information Sheet and submit it to the OTC no less than 2 weeks prior to arrival. All information and suggested roommate list as well as passport information for non-us citizens is due by 1/13/2011. If not received by this time we will be unable to support housing at the USOTC.**
